Private Mailbox (PMB) Rental Procedure

Complete the following procedure when requesting to rent a mailbox:

- 1. Read, agree, and sign the terms of:
 - Mailbox Rental Agreement Synopsis (Attached Yellow)
 - Mailbox Rental Agreement (Attached White)
- 2. Complete the Box Holder Information Form (Attached Triplicate)
- 3. Provide one (1) complete copy of each of these two (2) types of identification required by the US Postal Service
 - First ID Copy of your current valid state driver's license/identification card with picture
 - Second ID Copy of TAMU Student ID Armed Forces ID Voter Registration Card Vehicle Registration – University ID – US/Foreign Passport – Vehicle Insurance or Registration Card
- 4. Provide the appropriate rental fee payment. Mailbox payment will be:

Cash, Check, Money Order, PayPal, or Credit Card

- Mail-In Application Check/Money Order payable to SMS. Do NOT send cash!
- Emailed/Faxed Application Credit card via "Credit Card Authorization Form", available from SMS, or provide a PayPal account name/email for a PayPal invoice

Single Person Tenant

Fall/Spring Semester (mid-August to mid-May)	\$63.00
Summer Session (June to mid-August)	\$31.50

Two (2) Person Tenants

Fall/Spring Semester (mid-August to mid-May)	\$94.50
Summer Session (June to mid-August)	\$41.50

- 5. Return the above information to Student Mail Service Office(s):
 - In Person Commons Lobby (Rm #126) or Hullabaloo Hall (Rm #136)
 - Mailed Applications Use the above letterhead mailing address
 - Emailed Applications studentmailservice@gmail.com
- 6. Once your application is processed, a private mailbox (PMB) will be assigned in August. Come through the "Pre-registration" line during Howdy Week to retrieve your mailbox number and address information. You will have one last form (USPS-1583) to sign before we can accept mail/packages on your behalf.
